2021 - 2022

The accumulation of credits for graduation begins in grade nine and continues through grade twelve. A total of 24 high school credits are required as follows:

English: 4 credits

Mathematics: 4 credits

Social Studies: 3 credits (to include 1 credit in U.S. History, 1 credit in World History or World Geography, 1/2 credit in Political Science, and 1/2 credit in Economics)

Science: 3 credits (to include 1 credit in Biology, 1 credit in Chemistry, and 1 credit in another Lab Science)

Language: 2 credits of one foreign language (must be consecutive)

Fine Arts: 1 credit (in either art and/or music)

Wellness: 1 1/2 credits

Public Speaking: 1/2 credit

P. Finance: 1/2 credit
