Facilities, Maintenance, Janitorial, and Transportation

General Description

The Transportation, Facilities, and Custodial Coordinator is responsible for overall maintenance, custodial, transportation, campus, complex, and groundskeeping of Clarksville Academy. This includes daily operations and long-term projects. The Transportation, Facilities, & Custodial Coordinator reports to the Director of Operations and Security.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Her responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Supervision, and assists the Head of School, Director of Operations and Security, and Chief Finance Officer in the hiring and termination process in this department.
- Implements preventative maintenance of all facilities and equipment owned and operated by Clarksville Academy.
- Inspects school buildings and grounds to assure that proper safety, cleaning and sanitation standards are maintained.
- Inspects painting, carpentry, plumbing, electrical and other mechanical, maintenance or construction work performed by custodial or maintenance employees or private contractors.
- Utilizing school technology to schedule preventative maintenance on campus, sports complex, and vehicle inventory.
- Maintains and updates an inventory of building maintenance and custodial supplies.
- Preparing and coordinating daily maintenance plan for regular school year usage to ensure that all areas are maintained in a sanitary and clean condition.
- Works with the team and Director of Operations regarding response to emergency call-backs during off-duty hours.
- Responsible for reviewing all expenditures and submitting yearly budget requests throughout the year to the Director of Finance & Operations.
- Evaluate and research costs and savings.
- Coordinates with the main office appropriate temperature levels for all building on campus during campus closures.
- Supervises, evaluates, and coordinates vendor subcontracting and schedules for special campus projects and regular maintenance.

- Coordinates with team and contractors to ensure grounds and facilities are maintained at the highest standards.
- Reviewing and coordinating all maintenance and facility utilization requests to ensure maximum utilization of facilities, such as major events on campus, assisting with event set up and break down.
- Stocks concessions for events.
- Supervising school vehicle use and maintenance, which includes all bus routes and co-curricular event use.
- Ensures preventative maintenance and safety inspections on vehicles.
- Works with the Director of Operations and Security to maintain records concerning personnel, work requests supplies and other matters; prepare reports as required, etc.
- Assure that all safety requirements are followed by crew(s).
- Models high standards, supports the school and its leadership.
- Other duties assigned.

Qualifications

- High School Diploma or its equivalent supplemented by four years of responsible experience in building maintenance trades including at least one year of supervisory experience.
- Excellent verbal communication skills
- Impeccable organization, prioritizing, and management skills
- Physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform required duties.
- Knowledge of compliance of laws, rules, and regulations related to assigned activities
- Knowledge of health and safety regulations
- Knowledge of operating equipment to perform required duties and to train others on this equipment.
